REFLECTING ON 2024

2024 was a significant year as we approached a decade of working to transform Macon's streets. Over 8,000 people joined us at events like Macon Bike Party, Play Streets Macon, and our new initiative, Macon's Big Bike Ride. We also introduced new ways to explore the Ocmulgee Heritage Trail on Trails Day and celebrated important milestones, including the appointment of Macon-Bibb's first Traffic Safety Manager and a \$5.6 million federal safety grant for Gray Highway.

Riding in Rainy, Wintery Weather? Here's How to Stay Safe!

When riding in wet and chilly conditions, layer up with waterproof and insulated gear to stay warm and dry. Make sure your lights are charged and wear reflective gear to stay visible.

Prep your bike with fenders and test your brakes to ensure they're ready for the conditions. Avoid puddles that might hide potholes, and watch for black ice, especially in shady spots or on bridges. Take it easy, plan your route, and ride safe!
