Adult Conservatory: Acting the Monologue Ages 20+

Monologues are a core component of plays, films, and auditions, but can sometimes be overwhelming! This 10-week course, crafted for the adult actor, will focus on creating a fully-realized character within the span of a 3-5 minute monologue. Character development techniques will come from the Stanislavsky tradition of actor preparation as we break down beats, goals and objectives, given circumstances, and understand our character's plot-line throughout the course of the monologue. Actors will complete the course with a well-crafted monologue that highlights Biblical characters accounts that can be used for auditions or mono-dramatist performances. All experience levels will get something out of this class!
