Bike smart after dark. Here's some tips to stay visible and confident after sunset:

- ✓ **Lights** - GA Law requires a white light on the front and a red light or reflector on the back. Lights must be visible at 300 feet.
- ✓ **Be seen** - Wear bright, reflective clothing for maximum visibility.
- ✓ **Ride predictably** - Follow traffic rules and use clear hand signals so others know your next move.

✓ **Slow it down** - Visibility changes at night so give yourself and others extra time to react.



Whether you're commuting home or enjoying an evening ride, a few small preparations can make a big difference.
